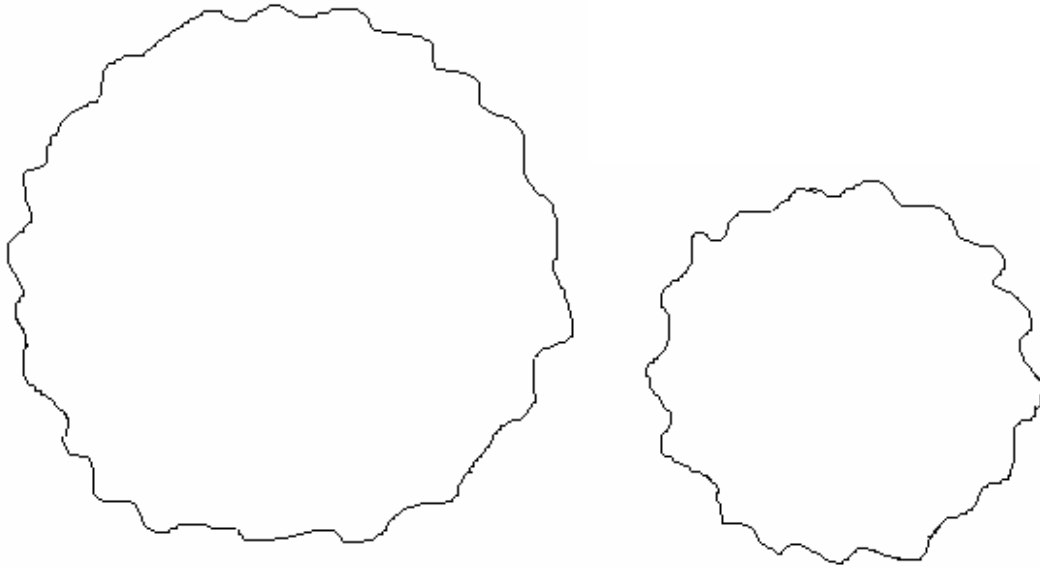


Tissue Paper Marigolds

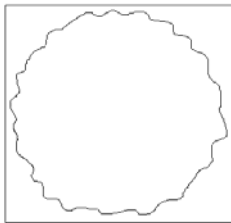
Supplies

- Orange Tissue Paper
- Pipe Cleaners
- Scissors

1. Make a photocopy of the patterns below



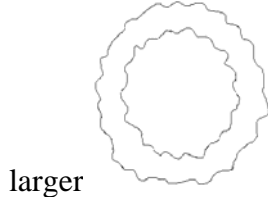
2. If using a large sheet of tissue paper cut it into quarters
3. Fold the tissue paper in half, and then quarters, and so on until you have a square the larger circle will fit in nicely



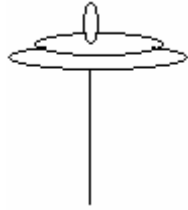
4. Trace the shape and then cut it out through all the layers of paper
5. Repeat this step for the smaller circle also
6. On one end of a pipe cleaner fold over the tip a few times to make a ball shape



7. Get 3 or 4 larger circles and 3 or 4 smaller circles and stack the smaller ones on the top of the



8. Make a small hole in the center of the layers of paper; if the hole is too big the pieces of paper will slip off the pipe cleaner
9. Slip the layers of tissue on the pipe cleaner; the smaller circles go on first then the larger



10. Fold each layer into a bud like shape; fold it up one layer at a time



11. Open your crumpled bud, one layer at a time, and shape your flower
