

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

Bonnets

Supplies: White sheets or 2 yards of muslin per 4-5 bonnets, scissors, fabric pen or marker. *Bonnet Example* and *Bonnet Pattern*

Time: 40 minutes with 5 students working

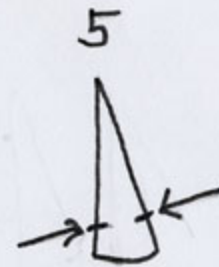
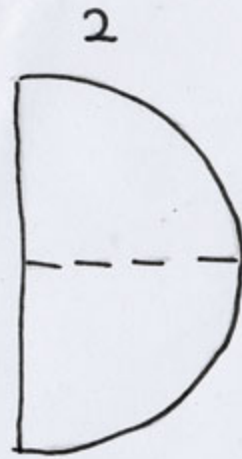
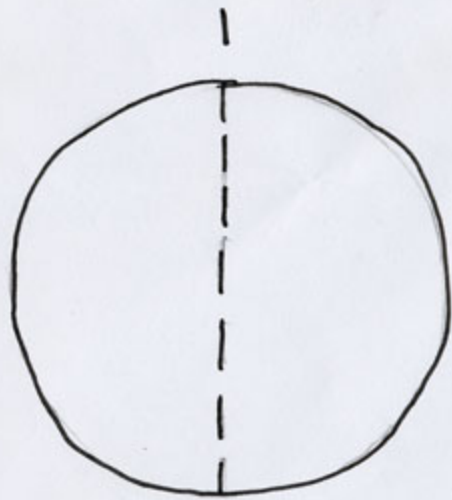
Instructor Prep work: the instructor must create patterns according to *Bonnet Pattern*

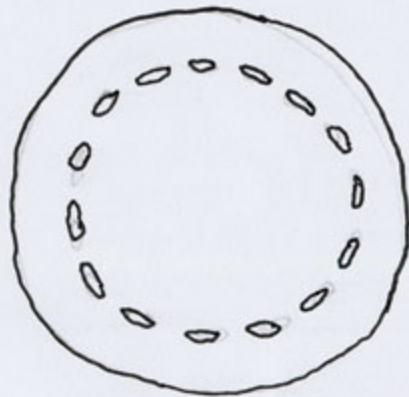
1. Trace *Bonnet Pattern* onto fabric.
2. Cut out bonnet and tie outlines.
3. Fold the bonnet into pie shape. *Bonnet Example* Cut slits in the pie shape one inch from the edge, according to the example.
4. Open up bonnet and run tie piece through the holes of the fabric in a weaving style, over and under. Refer to *Bonnet Example*
5. Place the bonnet onto the actress that will be wearing it. Tie with a bow in back and arrange the pleats around the face.

Bonnet Example

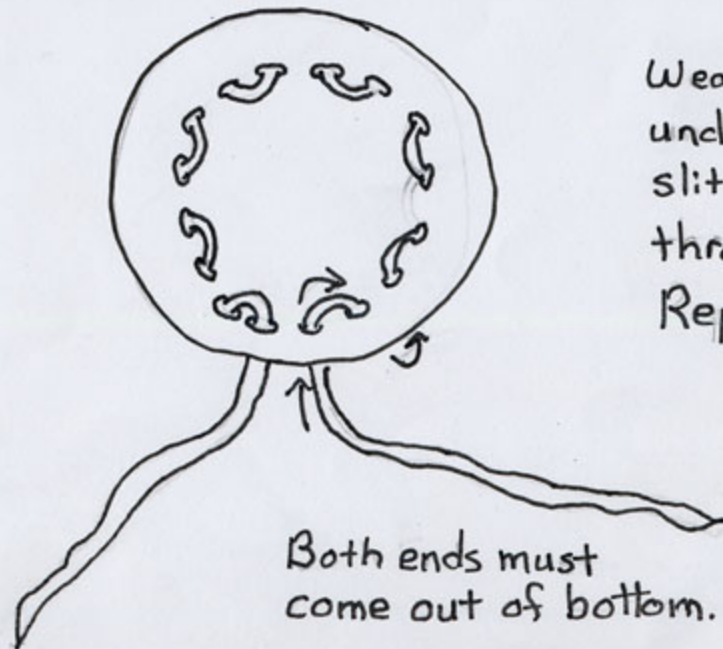


Cut slits through all fabric layers, 2 inches from bottom.

Fold fabric circle five times. *fill shape of pie*



Open fabric circle



Both ends must come out of bottom.

Weave tie, starting under and up through slit, over and down through next slit. Repeat.

Place on head and cinch, tie in a bow.
