

Sequencing Main Events

The Fredonian Rebellion worried Mexican leaders.

Immediately, the Mexican government sends General Don Manuel Mier y Terán to Texas.

Mier y Terán sees that Americans living in Texas are not loyal to Mexico and writes a report.

Mier y Teran suggests inviting people from Europe and Mexico to settle in Texas.

The Mexican Gov. imposes the Law of April 6, 1830; 1st canceling most empresario contracts.

2nd. The Mexican Gov. outlaws slavery.

3rd. The Mexican Gov. places tariffs/ taxes on good from the United States.

Last, the Mexican Gov. builds new garrisons and sends soldiers to Texas - Texas settlers become angry.
