I had my two classes work on the “Father of Texas: Stephen F. Austin” lesson plan in November and they had a blast. There were some kinks like:

They had trouble working with the maps and getting their images to enlarge in order to work with them more clearly

When looking at artifacts and pictures, they were confused about the transcript pages and how to use them

I found that if there was any writing that was more than a paragraph or so, they would usually abandon the piece rather than read it through, unless I was reading aloud, in which case they had no choice.

All in all, the lesson was very informative and there was a much more in-depth study of Stephen F. Austin than my classes had in the past.
