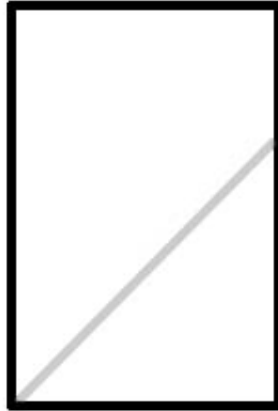


## Paper Flower Chain

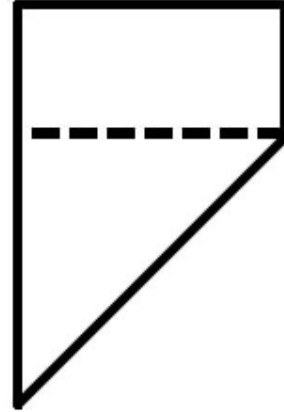

**Materials:**  
-One Sheet  
Paper,  
Colored  
Or Not  
-Scissors  
-Glue Stick  
-Markers/  
Crayons/  
Colored  
Pencils

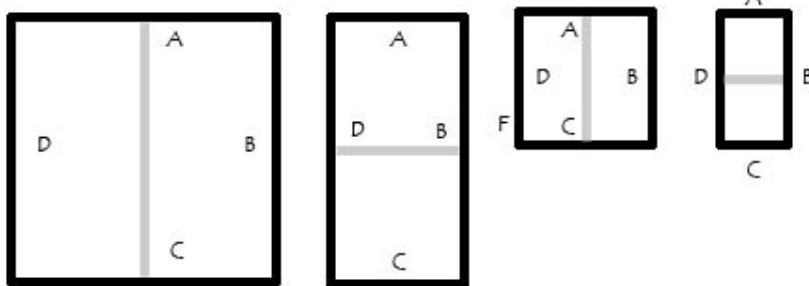
1. Fold the bottom right hand corner up so that the bottom of the paper meets the left side.



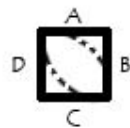
2. Cut at the horizontal line made by the fold.



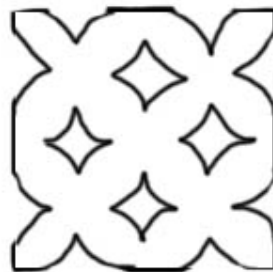
3. Fold as shown, making sure to keep the paper facing the same direction. You will make 4 folds.



4. While the paper is still folded, cut as shown, making sure to cut the correct sides.



5. When you unfold the paper it should look like this.



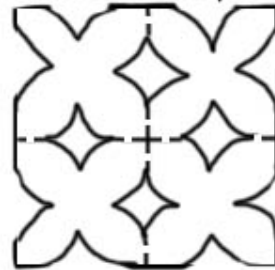

\* If you cut the wrong corners, it will look like this. Don't worry, just start over and recut. \*

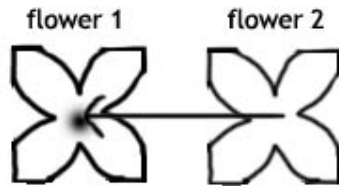


6. Cut between the flower shapes, as shown. You will have four flowers. Feel free to decorate the flowers at this point.

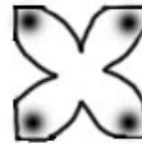

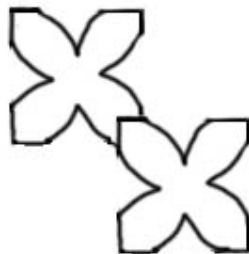
7. Put glue in the center of one flower. Place another right on top of it, and press down until the glue holds them together. Only the centers should be stuck together.



8. On the flower you just glued to another, put glue on the ends of each petal (facing up).



9. Take a third flower and glue one petal onto the second, as shown.



10. Take the bottom right petal of the third flower and turn it over, bring it to the top right petal of the second flower. Glue the bottom of the flower to the top of this petal.

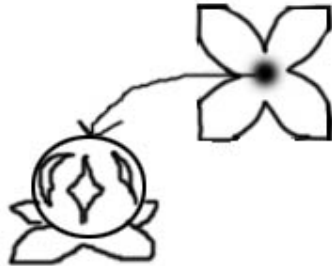
\*At this point, your flowers will look like this.\*



11. Glue the upward-facing open petals onto the top of the second flower's open petals. The second and third flowers will now be a ball, sitting on top of the first.



12. Put glue in the center of the fourth flower, and place it on the center of the ball.



\*Now it will look like this.\*



\*\*Each student will make one link of the chain.  
Glue them together in the middle of the flat flowers  
and hang around the room.\*\*
